SEVEN TOWERS HOLY WEEK PILGRIMAGE

Last month I wrote about the Holy Week Pilgrimage happening in our Benefice this Easter, and on the opposite page is the flyer advertising this event. Here are some of the details for the exhibition

There will be a 'launch event' at Sandhurst church on Sunday April 9th, at 6pm – a chance to have a glass of wine and meet the artist, Jonathon Brown, and hear him talk about his work in general, but particularly about this exhibition. Everyone is welcome!

From Monday April 10th – Friday April 14th the exhibition will be available to see in each of our 7 churches. You begin the story of Holy Week at Twigworth church, open from 10.00am – 2.30pm, and from there travel to Down Hatherley, Staverton, Boddington, The Leigh, Norton and finishing at Sandhurst, each of which will be open from 10.00am – 5.00pm.

In each church there will be 3 drawings from the events of Holy Week, beginning from the moment when Jesus is condemned to death through his journey to the place where he would be crucified, the crucifixion itself and his death and on through to his Resurrection and after that, when he appeared to his disciples. Instead of us looking up to Jesus in these pictures, we view the drawings as if from his perspective.

There will be a leaflet in each church with some description of the drawings and a thought for you to take away with you. There will be one leaflet for adults and another for children.

You can walk the pilgrimage – there will be a map available at Twigworth church; or you can drive; do the whole journey in one day, or take the whole week, doing it in stages – it's up to you!

The exhibition will NOT be open on Easter Saturday, but it will be open again on Easter Sunday and Easter Monday.

There is no charge for the exhibition but if you wish to make any donations in any of the churches it will be received with thanks.


We at Seven Towers hope so much that you will take the opportunity to make this pilgrimage in the week leading up to Easter.
