We plan to rehearse on a Tuesday evening, between 6.00 and 7.00pm at Down Hatherley church - so if you've got something else to go to at 7.30pm you should be able to make it! We shall probably meet 2 or 3 times before the 5th Sunday service, to learn the music we are going to sing at the service. We hope to sing a variety of styles of Christian music, from traditional to modern.

We would like our first 5th Sunday to be in the month of October - Sunday October 29th. More details about rehearsals and where the service will be, will be published nearer the time.
